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<sup>1</sup> Aetna received NCQA's Provisional Physician Quality (PQ) Certification. Provisional PQ Certification indicates that the health plan passed a subset of the requirements of the *Measuring Physician Performance* component of PHQ and is in the process of revising its program to pass the entire component. PHQ consists of two components: *Measuring Physician Performance* and *Hospital Performance*. Aetna's Provisional PQ Certification demonstrates the health plan's progress towards the standards of the Patient Charter. The Provisional PQ Certificate was available for a limited period (only through June 2009).
